

Construction update

Brisbane City, Petrie Terrace and Herston - March 2025

Brisbane City Council is delivering the turn-up-and-go Brisbane Metro. During March 2025, major construction in Brisbane's CBD will continue, including:

- tunnelling activities beneath Adelaide Street
- works to install new pavers on William Street, North Quay and Adelaide Street
- strengthening and resurfacing activities on Victoria Bridge
- finishing works on the new cantilever structure on the river side of North Quay between Queen Street and Ann Street.

Work will involve

- **Construction activities:** use of tunnelling equipment, road saws, hammering equipment, excavators, vacuum excavators, drilling equipment, cranes, trucks, concrete trucks, rattle guns, compaction equipment including vibrating rollers and plate compactors, as well as lighting towers and other construction machinery.
- **Noise, dust and light** can be expected from construction activities.

Traffic control will be on site, where required, to direct cyclists, pedestrians and commuters during works.

What to expect

- **Work hours:** both standard and out-of-hours works will be required in **Petrie Terrace, Herston, King George Square and on Victoria Bridge:**
 - Standard work hours:
 - Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm
 - Saturday, 8am to 1pm.
 - Out-of-hours work hours:
 - Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am.
- Work hours in the **Brisbane CBD:**
 - Works will occur continuously, 24-hours a day, Monday to Sunday.
- **Pedestrian and cyclist changes:** pedestrian and cyclist detours will be required around work areas
- **Traffic changes:** temporary road and lane closures will be required. Detours and traffic management will be in place
- **Bus stop changes:** temporary bus stop closures and relocations may be required
- **Vegetation pruning and removal** may be required and undertaken in accordance with Brisbane City Council's *Natural Assets Local Law 2003*.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of these works on nearby businesses and properties.

Brisbane City Council stormwater works

Over three weekends in March and April 2025, Brisbane City Council will complete essential maintenance works on the stormwater drainage system on Adelaide Street at Albert Street.

These works will require significant bus and traffic changes.
