

Construction update: Brisbane City and South Brisbane August 2025

Brisbane City Council is delivering the turn-up-and-go Brisbane Metro.

During August 2025, Brisbane Metro construction activities will continue, including:

- testing and commissioning activities in the Adelaide Street tunnel
- service installation including drainage and electrical works
- installation of steel balustrades
- landscaping, maintenance and finishing works.

Work will involve

- **Construction activities:** use of tunnelling equipment, road saws, hammering equipment, excavators, vacuum excavators, drilling equipment, cranes, trucks, concrete trucks, rattle guns, compaction equipment including vibrating rollers and plate compactors, as well as lighting towers and other construction machinery.
- **Noise, dust and light** can be expected from construction activities.

What to expect

- **Work hours:** both standard and out-of-hours works will be required:
 - **Standard work hours:**
 - Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm
 - Saturday, 8am to 1pm
 - **Out-of-hours work hours:**
 - Saturday, 7am to 8am and 1pm to 6pm
 - Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am
- Work hours in the **Brisbane CBD:**
 - Works will occur continuously, 24-hours a day, Monday to Sunday.
- **Pedestrian and cyclist changes:** pedestrian and cyclist detours will be required around work areas
- **Traffic changes:** temporary road and lane closures will be required. Detours and traffic management will be in place
- **Bus stop changes:** temporary bus stop closures and relocations may be required
- **Vegetation pruning and removal** may be required and undertaken in accordance with Brisbane City Council's *Natural Assets Local Law 2003*.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of these works on nearby businesses and properties.

Traffic control will be on site, where required, to direct cyclists, pedestrians and commuters during works.

Adelaide Street tunnel works

Until **late August 2025**, Brisbane Move is undertaking testing and commissioning activities in Adelaide Street tunnel to prepare the new tunnel for bus and metro operations.

These works are being undertaken on weekends and require a full closure of the Inner Northern Busway from Queen Street bus station to Roma Street busway station.

This means **Queen Street bus station, City Hall/King George Square station and Roma Street busway station will be closed from midnight Friday to 4.30am Monday on each closure weekend.**

All affected bus services will be maintained at alternative stops. Please follow signage to access your regular service.
