Construction update: Buranda busway station

August and September 2025

Brisbane City Council is delivering the turn-up-andgo Brisbane Metro.

As part of the Brisbane Metro project, Buranda busway station is being upgraded.

Construction works at Buranda busway station are nearing completion. Finishing works will continue in this location until September 2025, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Further information about construction activities during August and September are detailed in the table below.

Work will involve

- Construction activities: Use of road saws, hammering equipment, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, lighting towers, compaction equipment and other construction machinery and vehicles.
- Noise, dust, and light: Some noise, dust and light can be expected from construction activities.

What to expect

- Work hours: Both standard and out-of-hours works will be required:
 - Standard work hours:
 - Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm.
 - Saturday, 8am to 1pm.
 - **Out-of-hours works:**
 - Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am.
- Pedestrian and cyclist changes: Pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around work areas. Please follow signage in the area.
- Traffic changes: Lane closures and detours will be in place around work areas. Please follow signage in the area.

Traffic control will be on site, where required, to direct cyclists, pedestrians and commuters during works.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of these works, including noise and dust, on nearby businesses and properties.
