Construction update: Buranda busway station

June and July 2025

Brisbane City Council is delivering the turn-up-andgo Brisbane Metro.

As part of the Brisbane Metro project, Buranda busway station is being upgraded.

The station has opened extended platforms to accommodate the introduction of metro services M1 (Eight Mile Plains to Roma Street), and more effectively support current bus services.

Construction works at Buranda busway station are nearing completion. Finishing works will continue in this location until July 2025, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Further information about construction activities during June and July is detailed in the table below.

Work will involve

- Construction activities: Use of road saws, hammering equipment, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, lighting towers, compaction equipment and other construction machinery and vehicles.
- Noise, dust, and light: Some noise, dust and light can be expected from construction activities.

What to expect

- Work hours: Both standard and out-of-hours works will be required:
 - Standard work hours:
 - Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm.
 - Saturday, 8am to 1pm.
 - **Out-of-hours works:**
 - Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am.
- Pedestrian and cyclist changes: Pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around work areas until July 2025. Please follow signage in the area.
- Traffic changes: Lane closures and detours will be in place around work areas until July 2025. Please follow signage in the area.

Traffic control will be on site, where required, to direct cyclists, pedestrians and commuters during works.


Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of these works, including noise and dust, on nearby businesses and properties.

Location	Activities
Buranda busway station and South East Busway	Minor finishing works in the Buranda busway station.
	 Architectural finishing works and electrical fit-out activities in the platforms, busway tunnel and station plaza.
	 Hard and soft landscaping works in the station plaza including concreting garden beds and footpaths.
	Work is expected to continue until July 2025.
O'Keefe Street, between Carl Street and Gillingham Street	Construction of new steel structures, concrete planters and road furniture
	Footpath and kerb construction.
	Work is expected to continue until July 2025.
Hanlon Park laydown facility, near O'Keefe Street and Junction Street	Ongoing activities at the Hanlon Park laydown facility to support the Buranda busway station upgrade.
	Laydown facility will be in operation until mid-2025.
