

Construction update: South Brisbane

June 2025

Brisbane City Council is delivering the turn-up-and-go Brisbane Metro.

Council is upgrading Cultural Centre station to improve capacity for bus and metro services.

During **June 2025**, Brisbane Metro works are continuing in South Brisbane, including:

- finishing works on the new Cultural Centre station permanent platforms 1, 2 and 3
- works to upgrade the Grey Street and Melbourne Street intersection
- urban realm works on Melbourne Street and Grey Street.

What to expect

- **Work hours:** both standard and out-of-hours works will be required:
 - **Standard work hours:**
 - Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm
 - Saturday, 8am to 1pm
 - **Out-of-hours work hours:**
 - Saturday, 7am to 8am and 1pm to 6pm
 - Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am
 - Intermittent concrete pours from 12am to 7am
- **Pedestrian and cyclist changes:** detours and diversions will be required around work areas
- **Traffic changes and detours:** temporary road and lane closures will be required around work areas
- **Vegetation pruning and removal** will be undertaken as required in accordance with Brisbane City Council's *Natural Assets Local Law*.

Traffic control will be on site, where required, to direct cyclists, pedestrians and commuters during works.

Major construction and work timings are subject to weather and construction conditions. Thank you for your patience while we complete these works.

Works will involve

- **Construction activities:** the use of road saws, hammering equipment, excavation equipment, cranes, profiling and asphaltting equipment, concrete trucks, rattle guns, compaction equipment including vibration rollers, lighting towers, vacuum trucks and other construction machinery.
- **Noise, dust and vibration:** some noise, dust and vibration can be expected from construction activities.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of these works on nearby businesses and properties.

From Monday 2 June, the newly constructed Cultural Centre station platform 3 will open for bus services to West End and Highgate Hill.

The following services will move to platform 3:

**60, 192, 196, 199, N199, 202,
300, 301, 306, 322, 330, 333, 345, 385, 444.**
