

Sustainability Policy Statement

- Preparing for the challenges presented by climate change;
- Support and enhance social, cultural and community wellbeing;
- Commitment to continual improvement with the aspiration of achieving net positive impacts by means of restorative actions, both during design and construction phases of the project;
- Optimising the project's infrastructure design to ensure it is delivered to operate sustainably;
- Facilitate economic prosperity and development and provide a resilient local workforce;
- Encourage the pioneering of innovation in sustainable design, process or advocacy that seeks continuous improvement to promote new ideas and thinking;
- Ensure the application of sustainability-considerate procurement practices;
- Engage with our suppliers and subcontractors to procure materials and use them responsibly; and
