Construction update South Brisbane

Grey Street works, January-February 2025

Brisbane City Council is delivering the turn-up-and-go Brisbane Metro.

Major infrastructure works are underway in South Brisbane and will continue until early 2025.

From **January 2025**, Brisbane Move will commence the next stage of streetscape revitalisation and urban realm works on Grey Street and Melbourne Street, South Brisbane.

Works will include:

- night works
- traffic changes, with detours in place
- road resurfacing works, including profiling and asphalting
- construction of centre medians, kerbs and drainage channels
- line marking activities.

To minimise disruptions to public transport and road networks, activities will be undertaken at night.

What to expect

- Work hours: out-of-hours works will be required:
 - Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 7am
- Pedestrian and cyclist changes: detours and diversions may be required around work areas
- Traffic changes and detours: temporary road and lane closures will be required around work areas
- High noise levels can be expected from construction activities and machinery between 7pm and 3am.
- Some odour can be expected during asphalting activities.

Works will involve

- Construction activities: use of a road profiler, paving and milling machines, excavators, compaction equipment including rollers, lighting towers, vacuum trucks, concreting equipment, line marking equipment, trucks and other construction machinery.
- Noise, dust, light, odour and vibration can be expected from construction activities.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of these works on nearby businesses and properties.

Night works and temporary traffic changes on Grey Street

From Sunday 12 January to mid-February 2025 between 7pm to 7am Sunday to Thursday nights, the following traffic changes will be in place on Grey Street, South Brisbane to facilitate road resurfacing works. Normal traffic conditions will be in place daily outside these times.

- Grey Street will be closed to southbound traffic between Peel Street and Glenelg Street. A detour will be in place via Peel Street, Merivale Street and Glenelg Street.
- Local access will be maintained for southbound traffic between Melbourne Street and Glenelg Street.
- The northbound traffic lane on Grey Street will be maintained.
- Fish Lane will be temporarily closed at Grey Street. Detour via Hope Street.
- Commercial driveways and loading zones on Grey Street will be temporarily closed at times. Impacted businesses will be contacted in advance.

Traffic control will be on site to direct cyclists, pedestrians and vehicles during works. Please plan ahead and follow signage. See map over page for detours.

Night works and temporary traffic changes on Melbourne Street – January 2025

From Tuesday 7 January to Friday 10 January 2025, between 12am and 5am each night, crews will undertake night works on Melbourne Street between Hope Street and Grey Street, South Brisbane to facilitate road resurfacing works and streetscape activities on the busway.

These works will require lane closures on Grey Street between Peel Street and Russell Street, and on Melbourne Street between Hope Street and Grey Street between 12am and 5am. Traffic control will be on site to direct vehicles during works.

These works are expected to produce high levels of noise.
