Victoria Bridge resurfacing works - November 2024

Brisbane City Council is delivering the turn-upand-go Brisbane Metro.

Major infrastructure works underway on Victoria Bridge will continue until early 2025.

In **mid-November 2024**, Brisbane Move will commence resurfacing works on the Victoria Bridge footpaths and CityLink Cycleway.

To facilitate these resurfacing works, as well as ongoing strengthening works, temporary pedestrian and active transport changes are required until early 2025:

- The spiral ramp from Victoria Bridge to the Clem Jones Promenade will be closed for up to one week from mid-November 2024. Access along the Clem Jones Promenade will be maintained at all times during this closure.
- When the spiral ramp reopens, the upstream (northern) footpath on Victoria Bridge will close for up to three weeks. A detour will be available via the downstream (southern) footpath.
- When the upstream footpath reopens, works will commence on the cycleway and downstream footpath. During these works, either the cycleway or the downstream footpath will be open to allow access across this side of the bridge.
- A further short term closure of the spiral ramp will be required in early 2025 to undertake concreting works safely.

The timing of these closures will be dependent on the completion of the previous stage of works, and are subject to weather and site conditions.

Traffic management and wayfinding signage will be in place during these temporary closures.

Refer to the map overleaf for more information, including the key changes, indicative timeframes and detours.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of these works on nearby residents, businesses and river users.

Other key changes that will remain in place until early 2025:

- The CityLink Cycleway on Victoria Bridge will remain closed, but will be used as an alternative shared user path when the downstream footpath is closed. Following the completion of works, the twoway cycle facility will reopen.
- The Cultural Centre tunnel footpath will remain closed. A detour is in place via the Clem Jones Promenade.
- A section of the footpath underneath the Victoria Bridge abutment adjacent to the Cultural Centre tunnel will remain closed.
- Various intermittent overnight lane closures on the Riverside Expressway adjacent to Victoria Bridge, and closures of the Elizabeth Street off-ramp on the Riverside Expressway, will continue.
- A barge will be mobilised to Victoria Bridge for up to one week in October and December 2024 for strengthening works.

Work will involve

- Construction activities: the use of road saws, jack hammers, excavation equipment, concreting and asphalting equipment, a road profiler, paving and milling machines, compaction equipment including rollers, line marking equipment and other construction machinery, as well as increased truck movements in South Brisbane
- Noise, dust, vibration and light: from construction machinery, equipment and activities.

What to expect

Both standard and out-of-hours works will be required:

- Standard work hours:
 - Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm
 - Saturday, 8am to 1pm
- Out-of-hours work hours:
 - Sunday to Thursday, 7pm to 5am
